We are/I are of the "Unbound Solidaristi" group (unbound solidarity) and are committed to free entry of people on the run and against the fortress Europe. We are fighting solidarity with a broad alliance from regional to international initiatives for human -rectanging asylum policy and an open society. In the long term we want to achieve the abolition of government borders because this construct mainly leads to injustice and wars.

Today we want to draw attention to the asylum agreement recently adopted by the EU Interior Minister. This draft law is a sale of human rights and, among other things, enables multi -year detention of refugees, deporting to any third countries and the option for Union states to free themselves from the admission of refugees (€ 20,000/person: Proasyl source). Furthermore, the draft means no (acute, if at all) relief for the municipalities. Solidarity looks different! This design must be stopped!

In addition, we want to call on the local society to proactively participate in a respectful cooperation with refugees living here. Migrants' influx will continue for a long time, we cannot withdraw. It is about fulfilling our own values, the principles of solidarity and dignity.

We cannot rely on politics. There are local initiatives that show how it works. For example, the "Exchange" association, which runs a meeting point for locals and immigrants in Salzwedel. Or the Wendländische Initiative "CompassCollective", which has launched a foundation for an observation ship in the Mediterranean.

100 million people are currently on the run.

Everyone has the right to search for protection and security.

Therefore we demand:

Right to asylum: Anyone who flees from persecution, conflicts or human rights violations has the right to look for protection in another country.

Safe access: The borders should remain open to all people who are forced to flee - without access restrictions and limits.

No pushbacks: People must not be forced to return to a country if their lives or freedom were at stake.

No discrimination: people must not be discriminated against at borders. Factors such as skin color, religion, gender and country of origin must not influence the protection of life.

Human treatment: People who are forced to flee should be treated with respect and dignity. This also means: keeping families together, protecting people from human dealers and preventing detention.

Speech CompassCollective

First of all, I would like to extend a warm welcome to all those who have found the way from very far away (from Africa, from Ukraine, from Syria, from Afghanistan, from Pakistan. . .) to here. I'm glad that you're here and I'm also glad that more people are coming here in search of a better life (although not everything is in order here either - on the contrary).

I'm Katja from CompassCollective. We will support sea rescue in the Mediterranean with our group (and many activists who want to sail along). We only have a small sailboat. It's 13 meters long. But as long as people are still drowning in the Mediterranean, more and more small and large boats are needed.

We'll look. We will try to prevent PushBacks and PullBacks. We'll save the worst case scenario. For this we have many life jackets, long air hoses (centifloats) and lifeboats with us. And we will not leave the people in distress alone until they are safely aboard a larger ship.

We're just collecting donations to get things started in July. And in this context I got an email from a friend who accuses us:

“When you travel in lifeboats on the Mediterranean Sea, you are responsible for the deaths of people. Because with your NGOs you encourage people to flee. ”

I don't. I don't. It makes me angry. I refuse to accept that accusation. People do not flee because NGOs fish them out of the water. People have their reasons. These reasons are existential. And I'm not going to judge them, that's not my place. It's nobody's right to do that. Not even the Foreigners' Office and the BaMF. Everyone has the right to freedom of movement - even without a passport and birth certificate. There are no illegal people and there are no second-class people. Regardless of origin, every human being has an inviolable dignity and thus the right to life, physical integrity, sexual self-determination and the right to practise one's religion. The right to asylum includes the right to freedom of movement. The European nation states have been trampling these rights underfoot for years. “Fortress Europe” is being defended, with more and more border troops and fences. Borders are institutionalized racism.

We NGOs are not to blame when a boat with refugees sinks, but we are all responsible for people having to flee. Our capitalist way of life and our neocolonial structures reinforce structural injustice. That is why we do not accept that people are left to flee in their misery because of our economic interests, our ignorance and our intolerance and have to drown in the sea.

Wendland is sending a ship so that fewer people have to drown in the Mediterranean.

For safe passage, for freedom of movement and for a good life for all!

Speeches "Exchange" 24.6.2023

The immigration authority of the city of Salzwedel is the last link in the entire administrative apparatus of the Federal Office of Refugees.

Salzwedel is located in a structurally weak region. Accordingly, the search for work or a German course is difficult. Doctors hardly accept new patients. Pregnant women are referred to male women.

These are enough difficult living conditions. There is also a immigration authority, which hardly uses the scope that she has. Now new people have been

Started, we don't notice anything about it yet. Anyone who should work and even find a job often has to go to the consent of the

Immigration authority are waiting for the job to be awarded to another person until the approval is finally granted.

Or a father has been waiting for an answer for more than two years so that he can move in with the mother of the child. "You have to wait. It is like an exam "was the comment representative's comment.

Numerous people are waiting for their new IDs to be handed over. In theory, you have a residence permit. Only they have not received them to this day. Waiting times of 9 months to over a year are the rule. Without this document you cannot travel, look for a job. The letters issued by the immigration authority as a transition document are not taken seriously outside of Salzwedel.

At the meeting point for refugees, we are confronted with these everyday hurdles and an indifference that is hidden behind official decisions.

We demand from the authorities in Salzwedel and all other places to support all people in their needs and also provide the necessary translators that can also convey on cultural issues and problems.

It is not important that young people spend the best years of their lives to wait for official permission to work or start training. There has been talk of a shortage of labor for years. Here a specific way would be to train the necessary people.

Exchange supports refugees in their resistance against their deportation and tries to support them as possible so that they can build up a life perspective here.

If you want to get to know the Exchange, you are welcome to stop by during our opening hours. We can be found on Altperverstrasse 7 Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

The Exchange premises offer opportunities for various activities. It has space for new ideas and we are also happy about people who are willing to accompany refugees in the authorities, when visiting the doctor, etc.
